



2019 CAMPER CODE OF CONDUCT

AS A CAMPER I WILL...

- Recognize I am a part of the Quinipet community. I will respect other campers, staff, camp property, and the environment.
- Treat people the way I would like to be treated.
- Cooperate with camp staff and follow their instructions in activities and in the bunk.
- Practice sun safety by wearing sunscreen and staying hydrated with water/juice.
- Wear my life jacket at all times in all boating activities.
- Help keep my cabin and the surrounding environment clean and put all litter in trash cans.
- Take care of myself by taking regular showers, checking for ticks daily, brushing my teeth and changing my clothes regularly.
- Stay with my counselors, unless I have special permission not to be with them.
- Talk to an adult if I feel unsafe, uncomfortable or overwhelmed. Your emotions are as important as your physical health!
- Have lots of FUN, being willing and excited to make new friends and try new things.

AS A CAMPER I WILL NOT...

- Bring a cell phone to camp.
- Bring food to camp; I understand that other campers may have life threatening food allergies.
- Bully, or put down other campers or staff.
- Trespass, steal, vandalize or graffiti any property.
- Enter the rooms or cabins of others unless a member of that family group has invited me.
- Leave the cabin or camp property without staff supervision.
- Deliberately hurt anyone's feelings, including pulling pranks, which could cause someone to feel offended or unsafe.
- Have in my possession or consume tobacco products (including ecigarettes/vapes of any kind), alcohol or illegal substances of any kind.
- Have in my possession any type of weapon (including a pocket knife) or fireworks.
- Use foul or abusive language.

I UNDERSTAND that if I have trouble following this code of conduct, the following will happen:

- I will have a meeting with my counselor or one of the camp directors.
- A staff member may call my parents to discuss my behavior.
- I may be asked to carry out a suitable consequence decided by the camp staff, such as writing an apology letter.
- If my behavior is hurtful to myself, others or camp property, I may have to go home early.

AGREEMENT

I have read and agree to follow the Quinipet Code of Conduct. My camper(s) and I fully understand the camp policies and that there will no tuition refund for failure to follow the Camper Code of Conduct.

In addition, if a camper is displaying unsafe behaviors, such as talk of self-harm, parents will be notified and the camper will possibly be asked to leave camp. This is in care and concern of the safety and well being of the camper, as well as the safety of others at camp.
