REGGIE'S HOT CHOCOLATE

Makes 4-6 servings

INGREDIENTS

- +4 cups milk (pref whole or 2%)
- +1/4 cup unsweetened cocoa powder
- +1/4 cup granulated sugar
- +1/2 cup bittersweet or semisweet chocolate
- +1/4 tsp. pure vanilla extract

DIRECTIONS

Place, milk, cocoa powder and sugar in a small saucepan.

Heat over medium/low heat, whisking frequently, until warm (but not boiling).

Add chocolate and whisk constantly until melted and distributed evening into the milk.

Whisk in vanilla extract, serve immediately.








SANTA ORNAMENT
